Important

- You **MUST** start at the BSO Welcome page www.ssa.gov/bso.
- The first time you access BSO, select '**Sign In**'. If you do not have an ID.me or Login.gov, select '**Create account**' to verify your identity with one of our credential service providers.
- Your BSO User ID and password is no longer used to access BSO employer services. You must have an ID.me, or Login.gov, account to gain access to the BSO application.

Navigate the New Sign In Process!

The initial Social Security sign in screen looks the same for a business and personal account. It is important that you start from the BSO page to access BSO services. You will not be able to access BSO services otherwise.
