FOREWORD

The "Forecast of SSA's Contracting Opportunities for Small Businesses" is published pursuant to Public Law 100-656, Business Opportunity Development Reform Act of 1988," and SSA's plan to implement Executive Order 13170. The purpose of the Forecast is to inform small business concerns of the Social Security Administration's anticipated contracting opportunities during the cited fiscal year. It is the Social Security Administration's policy that small businesses receive a fair and equitable share of contracts awarded by the agency.

In fiscal year 2009, SSA acquired in excess of \$1 billion dollars in goods and services; of which 34% were awarded to small business concerns. The information contained in this forecast represents SSA's best estimate on the types of acquisitions that are most likely to be awarded to small business concerns during fiscal year 2010. The forecast should assist small business participants in effectively marketing their goods and services to the Social Security Administration.
