



# U.S. Citizen – Adult Change Name On Social Security Card

*To change your name on your card, you must show us documents proving your legal name change and identity. You must also show us a document proving your U.S. citizenship, if it is not already in our records.*

To prove	You must show
Your legal name change	<p><b><u>One of the following documents:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Amended or corrected birth certificate;</li><li>• Marriage document;</li><li>• Divorce decree;</li><li>• Certificate of naturalization showing a new name; <b>or</b> Court order for a name change.</li></ul> <p><b><i>We may ask to see other documents showing your old and new names.</i></b></p>
Your identity	<p><b><i>A document showing your name, identifying information and photograph, such as <u>one of the following:</u></i></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• U.S. driver's license;</li><li>• State-issued nondriver's identification card; <b>or</b></li><li>• U.S. passport.</li></ul> <p><b><i>We <u>may</u> be able to accept your:</i></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Employer ID card;</li><li>• School ID card;</li><li>• Health insurance card; <b>or</b></li><li>• U.S. military ID card.</li></ul>
Your U.S. citizenship	<p><b><u>One of the following documents:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• U.S. birth certificate;</li><li>• U.S. consular report of birth;</li><li>• U.S. passport;</li><li>• Certificate of naturalization; <b>or</b></li><li>• Certificate of citizenship.</li></ul>

***You must present original documents or copies certified by the agency that issued them. We cannot accept photocopies or notarized copies.***
